8. Awards

9. Machine safety

- a. All machines entered must comply with the AMA General Competition Rules
b. All entrants must hand in a self-check form of their machine at sign in and event payment before a scorecard can be issued.
c. It is the entrant/parents responsibility to ensure that any machine suffering accidental damage during the event and is repaired meets the AMA General Competition Rules.
d. Properly secured helmets must be worn by all competitors and referees using any bike, trike or quad.
